A number of follow-up actions can minimize the costs and maximize the benefits of demonetization, which include tax reforms, reducing stamp duties & tax rates, incentives for tax compliance, and facilitate the digital economy. To achieve these specific objectives, policy makers and academicians must visualize a developmental strategy for the road ahead during post-demonetization period.

Therefore, there are many issues and intricacies that need to be discussed pertaining to the new monetary policy of India in the form of Demonetization of nearly 80 percent of currency in circulation.
